Description: This position is a full-time faculty teaching position at Annunciation Catholic School. This teacher would be responsible for the instruction of 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, & 8<sup>th</sup> grade science classes, an 8<sup>th</sup> Grade math class, and serving as a middle school crew leader (Relevant curricula: Archdiocese of Denver Science Curriculum for 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, and 8<sup>th</sup> Grade, as well as the 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Algebra curriculum). This teacher, as a member of the middle school teaching team, will be consistently collaborating with the other teachers on this team to ensure a thriving middle school environment.
